

Golden Glory Corneliancherry Dogwood

DESCRIPTION

One of the first plants to bloom, Corneliancherry Dogwood greets spring with a profusion of small, star shaped blooms. The yellow flowers are produced in umbels and are attractive for several weeks. Edible red drupes mature in summer, but may be hidden by the dark green foliage. Winter interest is achieved by its rich brown exfoliating bark.

'Golden Glory' is a vigorous grower and is more upright than the species. It may be grown as a large shrub or tree form, and is an exceptionally heavy bloomer.

Plant this adaptable Dogwood in full sun to partial shade. Utilize as a single specimen, in borders, as hedges or screens and within foundation plantings.
