Rose of Sharon is an easy to grow flowering shrub. They are tolerant of summer heat, urban conditions and heavy pruning. Their large blooms provide color over a long period, from mid to late summer, attracting bees, butterflies and hummingbirds to the garden.

Sugar Tip™ is a Proven Winners® introduction that has attractive variegated foliage. Leaves are blue-green with a creamy white edge. Double soft pink flowers are produced and reportedly seed capsules are not.

Plant Hibiscus in shrub borders, foundation plantings, in groups or as a single specimen. It is nice for screening or hedges. Hibiscus may also be grown tree form.
