DESCRIPTION

Panicle Hydrangeas are hardy, vigorous shrubs with an upright growing habit. They may also be grown tree form. Large panicles of white flowers are produced in summer which mature to pink later in the season. Flowers are held on strong stems and are good for cutting. Panicle Hydrangeas are best grown in full sun. They bloom on new wood, ensuring reliable flower production every year.

Great Star has unique white flowers on upright panicles. Their petals are long and wavy, giving them a star shaped appearance. A long bloomer, with only hints of pink flower color in fall.

Utilize in borders, as hedges or as a single specimen.
