DESCRIPTION

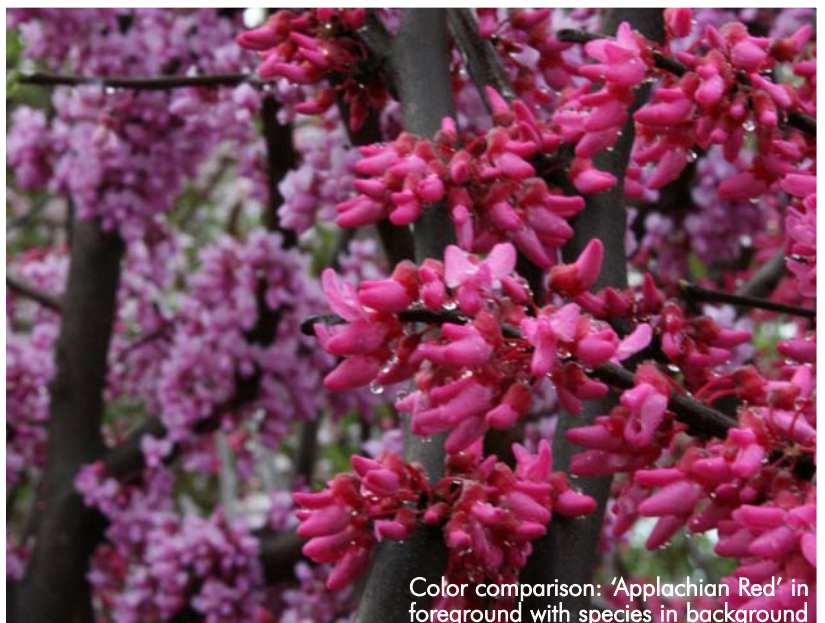
Eastern Redbud is a lovely native tree with a spreading habit. Its pea-like flowers are borne profusely along bare stems in early spring, and its dark green, heart shaped foliage is attractive during the summer.

'Appalachian Red' has bright magenta buds which open to vibrant neon pink flowers, a unique color among Redbuds! A heavy bloomer, 'Appalachian Red' creates a vivid spring display.

Redbuds prefer full sun to light shade and deep, well-drained soils. Feed regularly and water during drought conditions. Redbuds are beautiful within naturalized gardens, or plant in groupings, shrub borders, or as a single specimen.
