DESCRIPTION

Cotoneaster is a versatile and useful deciduous shrub offering multi-season interest. It has small leaves which are dark green and shiny during the summer, turning red to purple-red for fall. Tiny pink flowers in spring develop into bright red fruit in late summer. Fruits are showy and may persist throughout the winter. It is adaptable to various soil types and is easily grown.

Cranberry Cotoneaster has abundant large fruit and a compact form. Its dense network of branches root where they touch the ground, making it useful for erosion control. It is also appropriate for foundation plantings or for covering large areas in the landscape.
