## DESCRIPTION

Spirea is a popular landscape shrub that has a dense, mounded form and blooms profusely. Flowers are produced in flat clusters, covering the plant in early summer. Spirea will grow in various soils, except very wet, and grow best when sited in full sun.

'Anthony Waterer' displays an upright, rounded form with rose-pink flowers. Its blue-green foliage turns a wine to red color in fall and holds into late season.

Spirea is easy to grow and responds well to pruning, often displaying more flowers if trimmed after initial bloom. It is an excellent shrub for foundation plantings, massing, low hedges, or shrub borders.
