DESCRIPTION

Panicle Hydrangeas are hardy, vigorous shrubs with an upright growing habit. They may also be grown tree form. Large panicles of white flowers are produced in summer which mature to pink later in the season. Flowers are held on strong stems and are good for cutting. Panicle Hydrangeas are best grown in full sun. They bloom on new wood, ensuring reliable flower production every year.

The diminutive Bobo® will be completely covered in white flowers which lengthen as they bloom. Flowers may turn pinkish as they age.

Utilize in borders or foundation plantings. This dwarf is ideal for growing in large containers.
